BROADCAST MESSAGE (UP TO 5 PAGES, 12 LINES PER PAGE, 76 CHARACTERS PER LINE):

Effective immediately, ICBC will no longer accept responsibility for medically necessary physician services relating to motor vehicle accidents (MVAs). These services will now be billable to MSP in the same manner as any other claim.

Effective for LFP, claims submitted on or after February 23, 2026, services related to MVAs are no longer excluded from the LFP Payment Model. These services such as visits, procedures, counselling, and consultations may be billed under the LFP Payment Model for applicable settings. Both time and interaction codes can be submitted for these services.

ICBC-related physician reports (e.g., Standard Physician Assessment & Report - CL489) continue to be excluded from the LFP Payment Model. A physician must not claim an interaction or time spent on these reports. These reports are billable to ICBC via report or invoice using ICBC fee codes.
